













## **FY2018 SYSTEM REDESIGN**

Beginning Sunday, October 8, 2017

Route and schedule modifications will go into effect on Sunday, October 8, 2017. Through Mission MAX, benefits include:

- Shorter Trip Times
- Higher Frequencies on High-Demand Routes
- Better Connections
- Extended Morning, Evening or Weekend Service on Select Routes

Through **Mission MAX**, HART is **Modernizing** the system to deliver more efficient service and more frequency on high-demand routes. We are **A**ligning routes to provide shorter trip times and more direct service. And we strive for e**X**cellence by designing a network that lays a strong foundation for future expansion.

This redesign of the bus system will include route and schedule modifications based on an extensive period of research, operational considerations, and public input.
