Transportation Leadership Concerns

#### Dear Board Members:

We would like to express our concerns that there are significant problems concerning the transportation department's leadership in regards to the following:

1. ESE concerns started at the end of the 2007/2008 school year. ESE oversight Route Coordinators/Supervisors were deleted and/or eliminated for each area office as a part of Mr. Franklin's reorganization structure. Prior to the re-organization, each Red Alert student was paired with a driver who was provided appropriate training on the student's needs. We've become concerned about the transportation ESE program; the issue of the DRT office being offsite has caused problems and is not being addressed. The DOE ESE Class teaches students how to apply the safety vest and the securing of wheelchairs prior to bus transportation. As instructors, we believe there is a need for refocusing training and providing additional needed resources. The new DRT ESE, Renee Rybicki, is housed at an offsite location and there are many channels to go through regarding ESE medical emergencies. We have had several recent concerns involving safety and training. The Safety and Training Supervisor, Rebecca Stringfield, has instructed us to not document and/or overlook ESE issues pertaining to the Lopez incident and the Caminiti ramp incident. The Lopez incident Involved Trainer Corie Holmes who was instructed not to document an incident regarding a

medically fragile student who needed immediate attention, because he was not safe enough to be transported. The ESE student was I Twyla Tillman was on the ramp at Caminiti with supervisor Rebecca Stringfield and observed a medically fragile student on the bus. Twyla asked the driver if the student was Red Alert and/or medically fragile. The driver responded, "I don't know". Twyla looked at the route; it indicated the child was in fact Red Alert. Twyla confirmed with the school the student was a Red Alert student. Twyla informed her supervisor what I had found, she informed me that were not here to spot "Red Alert students."

- 2. We were told and you, as a board member, approved money for a training facility. We were told the modular would be at Harney road June of 2013.
- 3. We believe the school district and tax payers would save money by having the towing of school buses done in-house.
- 4. Drivers are evaluated on bus cleanliness, which includes the bus being washed. The bus wash has been down for almost 2 years.
- 5. The consultants should counter information with staff other than supervision, if you want the truth concerning transportation.
- 6. We support a standardization of promotion procedures within the Transportation Department.
- 7. We question why the department has buses yet newly trained drivers are told there are no buses. This forces drivers to ride with other drivers until a bus is available.
- 8. There are safety concerns since drivers have been stranded after 7pm because there's no staff from maintenance. Examples can be provided upon request.
- 9. We are losing drivers at an alarming rate due to morale and/or easily fixable logistics issues. Examples can be provided upon request.
- 10. We support two sets of paperwork and corresponding standards that outline crash procedures and 'incident' procedures. As of now, 'incidents' are deemed 'crashes'. This is a detrimental difference in one's personnel file.
- 11. The ESE and class 14/01 issues has caused internal strife and bullying throughout the department has ensued by supervisor Rebecca Stringfield and manager Willie Campbell.
- 12. On January 21,2014 In-service Training at Spoto High School for all bus drivers and riders regarding pre-trip inspections of buses for safety. The concern is we put many resources money into this training, but no checks or follow up if the drivers aren't actually doing this from a safety and training stand point.

- 13. Incident regarding Kindergarten Incident Report This case was clearly not investigated because the student parents being Hispanic. Standards for investigating should be investigated based on facts not race. (see report)
- 14. Jerry Rausch a newly trained Driver who was released from training January 22, 2014 who had significant training issues was involved in a crash. Jerry hit a mail box with a bus load of students. Jerry failed to report stop and or remain on scene as trained. On February 3, 2014 As training department we shared with supervisor Rebecca Stringfield our immediate concerns since Jerry failed his CDL test after his first attempt and only past by one point on his second attempt. This matter was given to our supervisor Rebecca Stringfield and to date Jerry is still driving a bus with students even after we collectively share this serious safety concern.
- 15. It should also be noted that we are doing very little from a proactive standpoint to conduct field observation concerning school bus driver's safety. We continue to be reactive to serious safety matters thus causing us to appear in the news. We lack oversight concerning school bus safety and leadership regarding the transportation department.







# Incident Report Bus 4717 (Kathy Tennyson) at Walden Lake Elementary August 26, 2013

#5684304) was put on the bus by his kindergarten teacher Karen Bendorf. Bus driver had been given a campus based bus pass on August 20 <sup>th</sup> . Lisa Hendricks, AP, gives daily school created bus rosters with all bus riders to each driver. Kindergarten students are listed. According to the teacher, the bus driver did not check off the student's names when getting on the bus.
1:27 Bus 4717 arrives at Mud Lake Mobile Home Park (stop 36). Bus driver was headed North on Mud Lake from Charlie Griffin. Parents were waiting on the East side across from the mobile home park. According to the parents, they were told on Friday, August 23 <sup>rd</sup> , they had to be on the eastside of Mud Lake to pick up their children. got off the bus (his mom was not at the bus stop yet). He attempted to walk across Mud Lake (in front of the bus) when Ms. Maria Mateo (parent of
1:50 mom, Belen Zamundo, arrives at Walden Lake Elementary. She reports that she missed the bus at the stop and her son has not arrived home yet. Mrs. McCurdy, ELL Resource teacher, attempts to call his teacher to verify that he was put on the bus. Teacher was not in her room.
1:55 Mrs. Hendricks, AP, calls transportation to locate driver. Spoke with Penny Baker. She was unable to locate the driver by GPS because she was in a spare bus and did not have the number. Penny stated that she was unable to contact the bus garage because there were so many calls coming in, she was not able to get a line out. Penny attempts to contact the driver again.
2:05 Corrie Holmes, Field Inspector, calls Walden Lake. He is on the phone with the driver. She has no WLE students on her bus. Mr. Holmes gets a description of

the student (small Hispanic boy with a red shirt and blue jeans). Mr. Holmes and Mrs. Hendricks agree to meet at the bus stop to locate the boy.
2:10 Mrs. Hendricks and Mrs. McCurdy follow the mom to their home at?  Mom checks the home and surrounding area. No child is found.
2:40 Mrs. Hendricks, Mrs. McCurdy and mom arrive at bus stop on the corner of Mud Lake Road and Charlie Griffin. Speak with Mrs. Garica-Diaz (daughter Mrs. Garica-Diaz saw lget off the bus and attempt to cross the street, but thought a patrol called him back on the bus. Mr. Holmes arrives at the bus stop. Begin search of the mobile home park. Mrs. Wyatt, Principal contacted Jerry Jackson at Area 6 office.
2:55 Mrs. Hendricks checks with the school. Mrs. Wyatt, Principal, initiates police contact.
3:00 Mr. Holmes drives across from the mobile home park to Mrs. Mateo's home.  is located at this home.
3:02 Called Walden Lake to report the child had been found. (Mrs. Wyatt still on the phone with Plant City Police Department) Once it was confirmed was found, the Plant City Police Department suspended the search.
